Nature of the Proposals

Application is made for the continuation of "deemed consent" but for a smaller extent of ground for the site. An area of land close to Craigward is to be available for business use. The existing storage arrangements are unchanged with a large circular storage tank holding 84 tonnes of natural gas.

Relevant Consultation Replies

There are no objections to this application from those consulted, as listed in the file.

Development Plan Position

The site has long been identified as a constraint and for consultation purposes in the zone of influence identified ion the planning acts. The position has not changed as following this proposal.

Planning Considerations

The key consideration is if any material change arises or is likely to arise due to the operational site being reduced in size. Consultations indicate there is no problem foreseen and generally the proposal is acceptable. The access arrangements from Craigward are assumed to remain unaltered.

Recommendation

It is recommended this application be approved with a covering letter (an informative) to accompany the consent notice. Such letter explaining the assumption over the access to the site, reiterating the comments received from Scottish Power and that notwithstanding this

decision any further proposals for any form of operational development in the vicinity should be the subject of a fresh planning application in each instance.
